III: Matters Arising

1. Insurance Renewal – Following the reply received explaining the increase in price permission was given to pay the premium of £884.37.
2. Co-option – The co-option notice has been posted. The clerk has received two expressions of interest so far. It was resolved that the clerk would e-mail all applicants after the closing date (24/6/21) asking them to send in a letter to explain why they feel they are the right person to fill the vacant seat.
